NHRA MEMBERSHIP & COMPETITION NUMBER INFO

NHRA MEMBERSHIP IS REQUIRED AT ALL NHRA SANCTIONED EVENTS You must be an NHRA member to run at the E.T. Finals. If you are going to participate in this year's E.T. Finals and you're not a member, you may pay for your membership along with your ET Competition number. The membership includes excess medical insurance benefits listed at www.nhra.com/insuranceinfo.aspx. Coverage may be different outside the US. **APPLICATION FOR NHRA MEMBERSHIP AT THE EVENT WILL RESULT IN A \$10 SURCHARGE.** PLEASE COME FULLY PREPARED.

NHRA E.T. PERMANENT NUMBERS ARE MANDATORY TO RUN AT THE E.T. FINALS – NHRA permanent numbers must be painted or decaled on your vehicle in a contrasting color to the vehicle's background color, or light color on windows. Check your NHRA Rule Book for location and size. All Motorcycle contestants must have number plates and dial-in plates on both sides of their bike. You must have an NHRA Competition number or License to run at the E.T. Finals. You may apply for your competition number when you are teched at your home track. **APPLICATION FOR NHRA NUMBER AT THE EVENT WILL RESULT IN A \$10 SURCHARGE.** PLEASE COME FULLY PREPARED.

NHRA COMPETITION DRIVERS/RIDERS LICENSE is required whenever you run quicker than 9.99 in the quarter mile (4.50 to 6.39 1/8 mile); no matter what kind of car or motorcycle you drive/ride. For license information, contact the Division Office at (816) 795-8055 or your local track manager. If you need to apply for NHRA license, you should submit your physical, application and test runs, along with appropriate fees, to the division office prior to the event. **APPLICATION FOR NHRA COMPETITION LICENSE AT THE EVENT WILL RESULT IN A \$10 SURCHARGE.** PLEASE COME FULLY PREPARED.

PARTICIPANTS MUST BE AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE TO RACE ANY VEHICLE IN NHRA SUMMIT ET FINALS and have a valid state driver's license beyond a learners permit. Any qualifiers 17 and under must have a notarized WAIVER signed by BOTH parents completed and available at time of registration at ET Finals. If you need one of these forms prior to attending the E.T. Finals, contact the Division Office at (816) 795-8055.

TECHNICAL INSPECTION – Tech will take place at your home track prior to the event. However, every racer must be prepared to be re-teched if asked. All participants must have proof of current NHRA membership and competition number with them at the event. Be sure that you have your track designation letter, i.e. BS, KR, TS, etc., along with your NHRA number on your car, visible to the tower (**HPT'S RACE CONTROL IS ON THE RIGHT SIDE OF THE CAR**). Each competitor will be responsible for turning in their tech cards to NHRA Registration to receive their run cards.

RUN CARDS – You must present your completed and signed tech card along with your entry ticket, proof of NHRA membership & competition number to the NHRA registration trailer to get your run card.

TIME TRIALS – All eliminator categories will be run in sessions. Each participant will only be allowed one time trial per session. Run Cards will be used for all time trials. Listen to the PA for lane assignments and times.

QUICK CHECK LIST

WHAT IS REQUIRED TO RUN NHRA WEST CENTRAL DIVISION SUMMIT ET FINALS?

- ✓ EACH COMPETITOR MUST HAVE COMPETED IN A **MINIMUM OF TWO EVENTS** AT THEIR REPRESENTED NHRA MEMBER TRACK IN THE CURRENT SEASON'S POINTS SERIES.
- ✓ **CURRENT NHRA MEMBERSHIP & COMPETITION NUMBER** PRIOR TO EVENT, OTHERWISE A FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR PROCESSING AT THE EVENT.
MUST HAVE ET # - SUPER COMP/GAS/STREET ETC. NOT ACCEPTED (ETMX & SM OK)
- ✓ **NHRA COMPETITION LICENSE** REQUIRED FOR ANYONE RUNNING QUICKER THAN 10.00 OR FASTER THAN 135 MPH IN THE ¼ MILE. PROCESSING REQUIRED PRIOR TO EVENT; OTHERWISE A FEE WILL BE CHARGED FOR PROCESSING AT EVENT.
- ✓ CLASS & ET COMPETITION NUMBER MUST BE DISPLAYED IN **PERMANENT LETTERING** (VINYL OR PAINT – **NO SHOEPOLISH**) CLEARLY ON THE VEHICLE, AS WELL AS TRACK/TEAM DESIGNATION LETTERS.
- ✓ ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST BE **AT LEAST 16 YEARS OF AGE**. ANYONE UNDER THE AGE OF 18 MUST HAVE A **NOTARIZED MINOR WAIVER** ON FILE WITH NHRA. THE HOSTING FACILITY MAY ALSO REQUIRE A WAIVER FOR THEIR RECORDS, PLEASE COME PREPARED.
- ✓ **ANYONE OF AGE 14-17** ENTERING A **RESTRICTED AREA** MUST HAVE A **NOTARIZED MINOR WAIVER** COMPLETED AND FILED BY THE HOSTING FACILITY BEFORE ENTERING A **RESTRICTED AREA**.

IF YOU ARE UNSURE IF YOUR CREW WILL REQUIRE A COMPLETED MINOR WAIVER CONTACT THE DIVISION OFFICE FOR RULE CLARIFICATIONS.
